There are four buses in total covering this bus route. AM service notes:

- The first two buses will depart from Raleigh Street, Essendon and pick up at Woodland Park (opposite 228 Woodland Street)
- The third bus departs from the Salmon Ave bus stop
- The fourth bus departs from the Glass & Napier St bus stop and continues to collect students from Salmon Ave bus stop and Woodland Park

PM service notes:

- All buses will stop at all bus stops on the pm journey.
- The first two buses will depart from bus bay 1 and 2, middle school at 3.40 p.m.
- The third bus departs bus bay 1 (middle school) at approximately 3.42 p.m.
- The fourth bus departs the Larkin Centre at 3.40 p.m., before collecting students from bus bay 1 (middle school) at approximately 3.45 p.m.
- Bookings are essential
- Please Note: Times may vary slightly as traffic volume, traffic lights etc., affect the speed of the bus.
- Students are asked to be at the bus stop 5 minutes prior to the scheduled departure to ensure they don't
 miss the bus.
